Dance: Advance contemporary dance and ballet

Circus: Intermediate - Advance Aerial Sling/Hammock + 1 arm hang and spinning on

straps

#### Beau

Dance: Intermediate - Advance contemporary dance and ballet + Partnering

Experience with overhead lifts like star

Circus: 1 arm hang and spinning on straps + another discipline

Gender: Generally a male, but am open for a female to perform this role

## Mrs. Flowers

Dance: Intermediate – Advance contemporary dance and ballet

Circus: Intermediate – Advance Duo Trapeze + Intro - Intermediate Silks is a plus

#### Mr. Flowers

Dance: Intermediate - Advance contemporary dance and ballet + Partnering

Experience with overhead lifts like star

Circus: Intermediate – Advance Duo Trapeze + another discipline

Gender: Generally a male, but am open for a female to perform this role

# Gingerbread

Dance: Advance contemporary dance and ballet technique

Circus: Intro Aerial Silks is a plus but not required

Gender: Male, Female or Non-Binary

## **Fish** (2 artists)

Dance: Intro – Intermediate contemporary dance technique + floor partnering skills

Circus: Intermediate – Advance Lyra + Aerial Silks

Gender: Male, Female or Non-Binary

## **Bracelet**

Dance: Intermediate contemporary dance and ballet technique

Circus: Acrobatics

Gender: Male, Female or Non-Binary

## Ballerina

Dance: Intermediate - Advance Contemporary Dance and Ballet technique

Circus: Bungee

Gender: Male, Female or Non-Binary
